A cool roof reflects and emits the sun's heat back to the sky instead of transferring it to the building below. This helps keep your roof cooler and reduces your cooling load and air conditioning needs. Hawaii Energy is offering an incentive of **\$0.20 per square foot**. Payment of incentives is not guaranteed as funds are limited, and amounts and offerings are subject to change. All incentive program terms and conditions apply.

#### ELIGIBILITY/INELIGIBILITY

- Incentive amount is based on the square footage over conditioned space that is cooled by an air conditioning system from an electric source.
- Due to heat transfer properties, concrete roofs are not eligible.

2. The Business Building Owner must present to Hawaii Energy two (2) documents in order for an incentive payment to be processed: the copy of the actual invoice **AND** the copy of permit for this roofing project.

In order to be eligible for Hawaii Energy's incentives, the contractor must install the qualified products. Please make sure that the contractor's invoice contains information about the product installed (manufacturer's name and brand).
